The Tourism Authority of Thailand (TAT), Pattaya Office, has introduced the second phase of the "TAT Hot Deal@Pattaya, Chonburi" promotion.

According to TAT, the campaign which was launched on July 1 was popular as all 8,000 discount vouchers from 92 business owners were sold out within the month. Elevated road expansion complete

The Department of Highways has completed the expansion of the elevated road at Bang Pa-in intersection in Ayutthaya's Wang Noi district.

The project will help ease traffic from Bangkok to the North and the Northeast. The expansion started at Highway 1 (Phahon Yothin Road) from KM50+900 to KM55+450. The distance is 4.55km in total. In addition, the Department of Highways expanded the inbound road to four lanes to eliminate a traffic bottleneck at the intersection. The investment cost a total of about 305 million baht.
