

Land cleared for high-speed rail project

Land clearing along a 3.5km stretch of a high-speed railway from Klang Dong to Pang Asoke in Nakhon Ratchasima province has been completed after more than two years of work.

Deputy director-general of the Department of Highways Apirat Chaiwongnoi said staff had finished clearing the land for the first part of

the Bangkok-Nong Khai high-speed railway and will hand over the job to the State Railway of Thailand (SRT) this month.

The work was done under a memorandum of understanding signed between the department and the SRT. It consisted of removing old train tracks and building a service road.
