



## Announcement of Department of Highways

Subject: Policy of not accepting neither gifts nor profits from performing duties (No Gift Policy)  
Fiscal year 2024

---

The Department of Highways is aware of and committed to practicing good governance, upholding ethical standards in its operation, maintaining integrity, having no conflict of interest, prioritizing the public interest over personal interest, as well as preventing and reducing risks that may cause corruption and misconduct in the public sector. These are in line with the National Reform Plan for Prevention and Suppression of Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Edition) that specifies important reform activities, activity no. 4, the development of the Thai bureaucracy to be transparent without benefit. This is stated in Objective 1, Section 1.1: All government agencies must declare that their officials do not accept any form of gift or present in performing their official responsibilities, which is called the No Gift Policy.

As the Executive of the Department of Highways, I wish to declare my intentions that “all government officials shall not receive any form of gift or present in exchange for their services; such malpractice shall not occur during, prior to, or subsequent to the performance of duties that will lead to present or future corruption and misconduct.” Additionally, fostering the development of a work environment and a set of principles that uphold integrity and fortifying the organizational culture to ensure that it is ethical, transparent, robust, and sustainable are also my intentions.
